Tuition Adjustment

Discover our TEAM approach to financial accessibility. Our goal is to make our school accessible to as many families as possible. If you are applying for an adjustment to your tuition, please fill out the School and Student Services application.

Multiple Child Discount

Families with more than one child in Pre-1st (age 5 by June 1, 2024) - Grade 8 may take: 10% tuition discount on their second child's Pre-1st - Grade 8 tuition | 50% discount on their third child's Pre-1st - Grade 8 tuition | 75% discount on their fourth, etc. child's Pre-1st - Grade 8 tuition..

Payment Plans

A signed contract and non-refundable enrollment deposit of \$600/student (\$300/sibling) reserves your child's space for the school year and will be applied towards total tuition due. The balance of tuition may be paid in one of the following ways:

Early Payment Plan

If cash or check payment for the total tuition due is received in the UVWS office by June 1, a reduction of 2.0% will be given on the balance remaining after the deposit and any discounts.

Monthly Payment Plan

Pay in eleven equal installments July-May. This payment plan is administered by FACTS and carries an annual service charge of \$50 per family.

Pay Ahead

You may make payments to reduce your tuition balance at any point and the remaining monthly payments through FACTS will be adjusted accordingly.

Additional Fees

Class Fees

While nearly all program and school supply costs are included in tuition, there are some incidental and grade specific activities with associated fees. Below is a general overview of additional expenses that you can assume will occur. Prices are based on last year's purchases and may increase. Each class (including subject classes) has a modest field trip/cultural event budget. Parents do not pay for these outings except where noted below:

First Grade

- Wooden recorder **\$75***

Third Grade

- Wooden recorder **\$75***
- Farm Visits and Farm Trip - fully funded but appropriate clothing and footwear may be an added expense.
- Violin rental and private or semi-private lessons

Fourth Grade

- Violin rental and private or semi-private lessons.
- Wooden recorder if not purchased in grade three.

Fifth Grade

- Soprano recorder **\$16***
- Stringed instrument rental and private or semi private lessons.
- Pentathlon - fully funded, but parent volunteers needed to prepare/serve food.

Sixth Grade

- Alto recorder **\$25***
- Stringed instrument rental and private or semi-private lessons.

Seventh Grade

- Stringed instrument rental and private or semi-private lessons.
- Quebec trip - fully funded, but spending money for your student will be an extra expense.

Eighth Grade

- Stringed instrument rental and private or semi-private lessons.
- Eighth grade trip - parents are responsible for balance not covered by class fundraising.
- Yearbooks - if class chooses to produce a book it will be an extra cost.
